THE EUROPEAN REGULATION (EC) No. 1907/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND THE COUNCIL OF 18 DEC 2006 GIVE REACH THE FOLLOWING MEANING:

REACH is a European Union regulation concerning the **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorisation and restriction of **C**hemicals. The legislation entered into force on 1st June 2007 to streamline and improve the former legislative framework on chemicals of the European Union (EU). The key aim of its implementation is to protect human health and the environment from the risks arising from the use of chemicals. Under REACH, the responsibility for demonstrating the safe use of chemical substances will be transferred from regulators to industry. All manufacturers and importers of substances in quantities higher than 1 tonne per year will be responsible for assessing and managing risks and providing appropriate safety information to their users. A major part of REACH is the requirement for manufacturers / importers to register their substances with a central [European Chemicals Agency \(ECHA\)](#). The ECHA located in Helsinki, Finland has a central co-ordination and implementation role in the overall process. It will manage the technical, scientific and administrative aspects of the REACH system to ensure consistency across the European Union.

TO THE BEST OF OUR KNOWLEDGE TALYA'S PRODUCT DO NOT CONTAIN ANY SUBSTANCE OF VERY HIGH CONCERN (SVHC) AS DEFINED IN REACH.

ALL TALYA PRODUCTS CAN BE 100% RECYCLED, AND AT THE END OF THEIR LIFE CYCLE, THEY WILL BE COLLECTED, WASHED AND REGROUND TO BE USED IN THE INTERNAL LAYERS OF NEW PRODUCTS.

Dear Customer,

We are pleased to announce that Carmel Olefins Ltd. has completed the pre-registration of the monomers and substances related to its polypropylene resins commercialized under the name Capilene[®] and to its polyethylene resins commercialized under the name Ipethene[®].

The pre-registration was done by Carmel Olefins' **Only-Representative (OR)** Domo Polypropylene B.V., with compliance with Regulation (EC) No. 1097/2006 concerning the **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorization and the Restriction of **C**hemicals (**REACH**).

In line with **CEFIC**'s recommendation, Carmel Olefins has decided not disclose pre-registration numbers. The reason is that different numbers may exist for a given substance. Knowing the number alone will not offer any added value to the customer since it is not sufficient to guarantee compliance within **REACH**.

Reach Declaration

Dear Customer,

We are writing to assure you that all substances (that require registration under REACH) contained within Tosaf Compounds Ltd products supplied directly to E.U. customers before December 2008 have been pre-registered by 30th November 2008.

Those substances which are indirectly supplied to E.U. (i.e. supplied by our customers into the E.U. in the form of a preparation) have been pre-registered. However in this case we need to be informed by you which materials are being supplied into the E.U. in order to ensure that all the substances are being considered.

This applies unless you are informed otherwise regarding the status of individual products.

After December 2008 we will be checking our records on a regular basis to ensure that no new substances that are not already pre-registered are supplied directly to E.U. customers. For non EU customers who begin exporting new masterbatches into the E.U. you will need to inform us. If additional substances are supplied directly or indirectly into the E.U. after December 2008, then we will ensure that the necessary "late pre-registrations" are submitted within the relevant timescales.

We also expect that all substances that require registration will be registered by the applicable deadlines. This will either be done by Tosaf or by our upstream suppliers.

This work is being co-ordinated by our E.U. based company, Colloids Ltd., who are acting as our "only representative" for substances where necessary.
